

Itinerary

Delhi – Amritsar - Delhi

02 Nights / 03 Days

Day 1

: Delhi – Amritsar (Fly)

- Pick up from your place of stay in Delhi
- Transfer to Delhi Airport
- Meet upon arrival in Amritsar
- Check-in to hotel
- Witness the flag ceremony at Wagah Border
- Overnight at the hotel

In the morning, pick up from your place of stay in Delhi and transfer to Delhi airport to board flight 9W 6E 362 at 1200 hrs. Meet on arrival at Amritsar airport at 1325 hrs and transfer to hotel for check-in.

Later this afternoon, precede to Wagah border to witness the flag ceremony at India & Pakistan Border - The final frontier, Wagah about 28 kms. **Wagah Border** is located at a distance of 28 kilometers from Amritsar. It is the only border crossing between India and Pakistan. It is an army outpost to protect & check intrusion from Pakistan and prevents any Indian from entering to Pakistan. At the border outpost, there is a complex of buildings, roads and barriers on both sides. At the entrance of this outpost, there is a sightseeing gate with an inscription "Swarna Jayanti" which means Golden Jubilee. From this a panoramic view of the landscape is seen. There are electrified fences with 66,000 volts of electric current. One can witness the "**Beating the Retreat**" ceremony performed by the soldiers in evening. Soldiers from both India and Pakistan perform a flag march. The flags of both the countries are brought down & then the gates between India and Pakistan are opened. Soldiers perform some drills and then the complex is illuminated.



After this unique experience drive back to your hotel for an overnight stay.

Day 2

Day 2: In Amritsar

- Breakfast at the hotel
- City tour of Amritsar
- Afternoon at leisure
- Overnight at the hotel

After your breakfast this morning visit Golden Temple. Golden Temple in Amritsar is one of the most ancient and fascinating cities of India. It is an important seat of Sikh history and culture. Being the gateway for travelers coming to India on the overland route from central Asia it soon became the centre of various commercial activities. The most famous of them all in the Golden Temple which was founded by the fourth Guru of Sikhs, Guru Ramdas and completed by his successor Guru Arjan Dev.



Also, visit **Jallianwala Bagh**: This place noted for its most notorious massacre under British rule. It is 400 meters north of the Golden Temple. The British General Dyer was the Lieutenant Governor of the province in 1919. He banned all meetings and demonstrations led by Indians against the economical set back by World War I. On 13 April 1919, pilgrims poured into Amritsar to celebrate the Baisakhi festival, a holiday in the Sikh calendar. In the afternoon thousands of people gathered at Jallian Wala Bagh to celebrate the Baisakhi. This ground surrounded by high walls on all sides has only a narrow alley for access. General Dyer personally led the troops to the sight and ordered his men to open fire without any warning. It resulted in the death of 379 and injured more than 1200. India was outraged by Dyer's massacre. Gandhiji, called for a nationwide strike and started the Non-cooperation Movement, which became an important mile stone in the struggle for India's Independence. Today this ground has been changed to a park and it has a pleasant garden. There is a narrow path between the houses which leads to the lawn of the park. At the entrance there is a memorial plaque which recounts the history. There is a well on the north side in which many people who tried to escape from the bullets were drowned, and remnants of walls have been preserved to show the bullet holes. At the east end of the garden there is a large memorial built in memory of those who died here.

Afternoon at leisure. Overnight at the hotel.

Day 3

- Breakfast at the hotel
- Check-out and transfer to Amritsar airport
- Meet upon arrival at Delhi airport
- Drop to your place of stay in Delhi

Morning after breakfast in time check-out from hotel and transfer to airport to board flight 9W 762 at 0855 hrs to Delhi.

Meet on arrival in Delhi at 1005 hrs and transfer to your place of stay.
